## Buenaventura, CO – Civil Strike Update 4

Today is the 17th day of the strike. Unfortunately the local situation had deteriorated as privates and public offices are closed. No public transportations and transit from/to BUN remain very restricted. Below information still in place:

- ✚ Strike remains effective in Buenaventura.
- ✚ Daily talks between Governmental Institution and local organization are still in place, however no changes on below situation

Some exports remain at depots and are not able to gate-in at the port; others are blocked in the roads and have not accessed to the city.

- Imports remain at the Terminal and not able to gate-out
- The strikers committee ask to the government representatives to meet the magistrates
- Mobility of vehicles from/to Buenaventura will be done by trucks conveys with police supervision

The berthing line-up and Services have been not affected and the Terminal Yard is at 70% of their capacity.

We will continue to keep the organization informed.
